#### 1 Samuel 16:1-13

- David as the anointed leader. The person God calls to lead may not be the person we would expect.

#### John 9 9:1-41

Jesus heals the blind man on the Sabbath. Lots of stuff about blindness and seeing.

Jesus heals a man born blind. He heals him through an act of anointing where he creates mud with his saliva. John 9:6: "When Jesus had said this, he spat on the ground and made mud with saliva and spread the mud over the man's eyes." Here Jesus is redoing Genesis where God created Adam and Eve out of mud. The word Adam is from the Hebrew word Adamah and means "mud creature". Jesus is restoring the man to his "original state". The man born blind was never a sinner, although he was judged a sinner by his community who determined that his lack of sight was a punishment from God. In anointing him with the mud of creation Jesus makes clear that the man born blind always was and is an original blessing, blessed to be a blessing to others. The man born blind is also anointing as a king in the new creation inaugurated by Jesus. The new creation is a state of utter unity with God knowing that God is everywhere.

#### |COVID-19 Response

This is a stressful and challenging time for Australia and the global community.

The spread of the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) in Australia is causing profound disruption to our lives and to the ministry of our Church communities. This disruption is likely to intensify before the situation begins to improve.

It is important that we take steps to protect and care for our people, many of whom are in the demographic groups most vulnerable to the virus. In order to express Christ's concern for all people, especially the elderly and vulnerable, we have decided to suspend all services, activities, and meetings effective immediately. This is in line with directives from the Grafton Diocese and the Province of the Anglican Church in New South Wales and the ACT.

While the physical health of our communities is paramount, we remain committed to our call to share the Good Life.

Historically, in times of social need, the Church has always made a significant contribution to protecting and caring for others. The current situation is no different. While there may be many routine things that we cannot do in the coming months, with creativity and planning we will have a key role to play. It is not time for the church to retreat from ministry, but to step up. It is not a time to forget our call to care and compassion, but to live it out as fully as possible.

We shall be communicating with you as to how we continue to care for each other. We shall also be developing multiple ways to provide spiritual nourishment. We shall make every effort to care for our church community and the wider public, especially those who are isolated and vulnerable.

We call on all Christians to pray for health workers and those seeking to develop a vaccine, and to pray that the spread of this disease may slow.
